The Steel Works

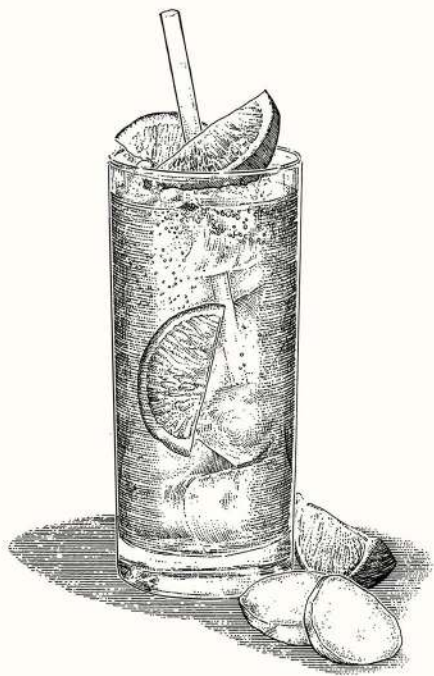
A quintessential part of Teesside's history, this cocktail is inspired by the late, great Steelworks; founded by Dorman Long in 1917. The steel production that took place here was used to build structures including The Sydney Harbour Bridge and The Tyne Bridge!

We couldn't create this menu without including one of the most prominent parts of Teesside's heritage.

This cocktail incorporates flavours of ginger and cinnamon through the combination of Ginger beer, Goldschlager and Tiki Fire rum. It is then served sparkling, to ensure complete authenticity!

The Transporter

Named after the unmissable Teesside landmark, we've dedicated this cocktail to the Tees Transporter Bridge. Erected in 1911, the vibrant blue structure can be seen for miles by many across Teesside.

The Daisy

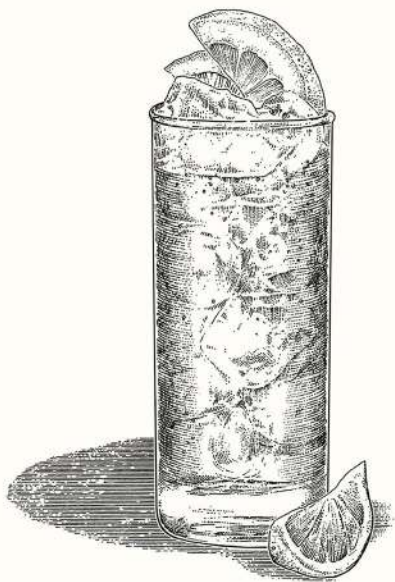
A partner cocktail to *The Gatsby*, The Daisy is a delicate and aromatic cocktail.

The Flood

Named after The Great Flood of Yarm, this cocktail is dedicated its infamous namesake that ripped through Yarm High Street in the late 18th Century!

It is said that some parts of the High Street were submerged in almost 20 feet of water when The River Tees burst its banks on the 17th November 1771! Despite this unfortunate history, we wanted to celebrate the community spirit and the support that was shown to the people of Yarm during this tragic event!

The Flood cocktail combines Snow Leopard Vodka with pear juice & pear syrup, and is topped with a splash of Fever Tree Ginger Ale.

Moonshine Cooler

We couldn't create a menu dedicated to The Great Gatsby without mentioning moonshine!

Behind all the glitz and glamour, lies this shady beverage! The mid 1920s, when The Great Gatsby novel was published, saw the height of the prohibition era, when moonshine was produced under the cover of darkness, and was enjoyed by many during the roaring 20s!

Our Moonshine Cooler embodies all the glamour of the 20s, but we've swapped out the moonshine for tangy Grapefruit Ciroc Vodka. We add grapefruit juice, Gomme syrup and a squeeze of grapefruit then blend into a frozen daiquiri to create a cocktail fit for the great gatsby himself!
